1-2 Don't be in any rush to become a teacher, my friends.

3-5 A bit in the mouth of a horse controls the whole horse.

5-6 It only takes a spark, remember, to set off a forest fire.

10-12 My friends, this can't go on.

Apple trees don't bear strawberries, do they?

Raspberry bushes don't bear apples, do they?

You're not going to dip into a polluted mud hole and get a cup of clear, cool water, are you?






34-37 “You have minds like a snake pit! How do you suppose what you say is worth anything when you are so foul-minded?






