# 1 Corinthians 11:23-26 (NASB 1995)

<sup>23</sup> . . . the Lord Jesus in the night in which He was betrayed took bread; <sup>24</sup> and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, “This is My body, which is for you; **do this in remembrance of Me.**”

<sup>25</sup> In the same way He took the cup also after supper, saying, “This cup is the new covenant in My blood; **do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me.**”

<sup>26</sup> For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord’s death until He comes.



**Remembrance** – *remembering, recalling, recollecting, reminiscing, mental image.*

Three ways of doing this that you may like to try

**Prayer**

Involves talking to God and God talking to you.

*(Includes listening!)*

**Praise**

Thanking God for the things he has done, is doing, and is going to do.

**Worship**

Adoring God, not so much for what He has done, but for who He is.
