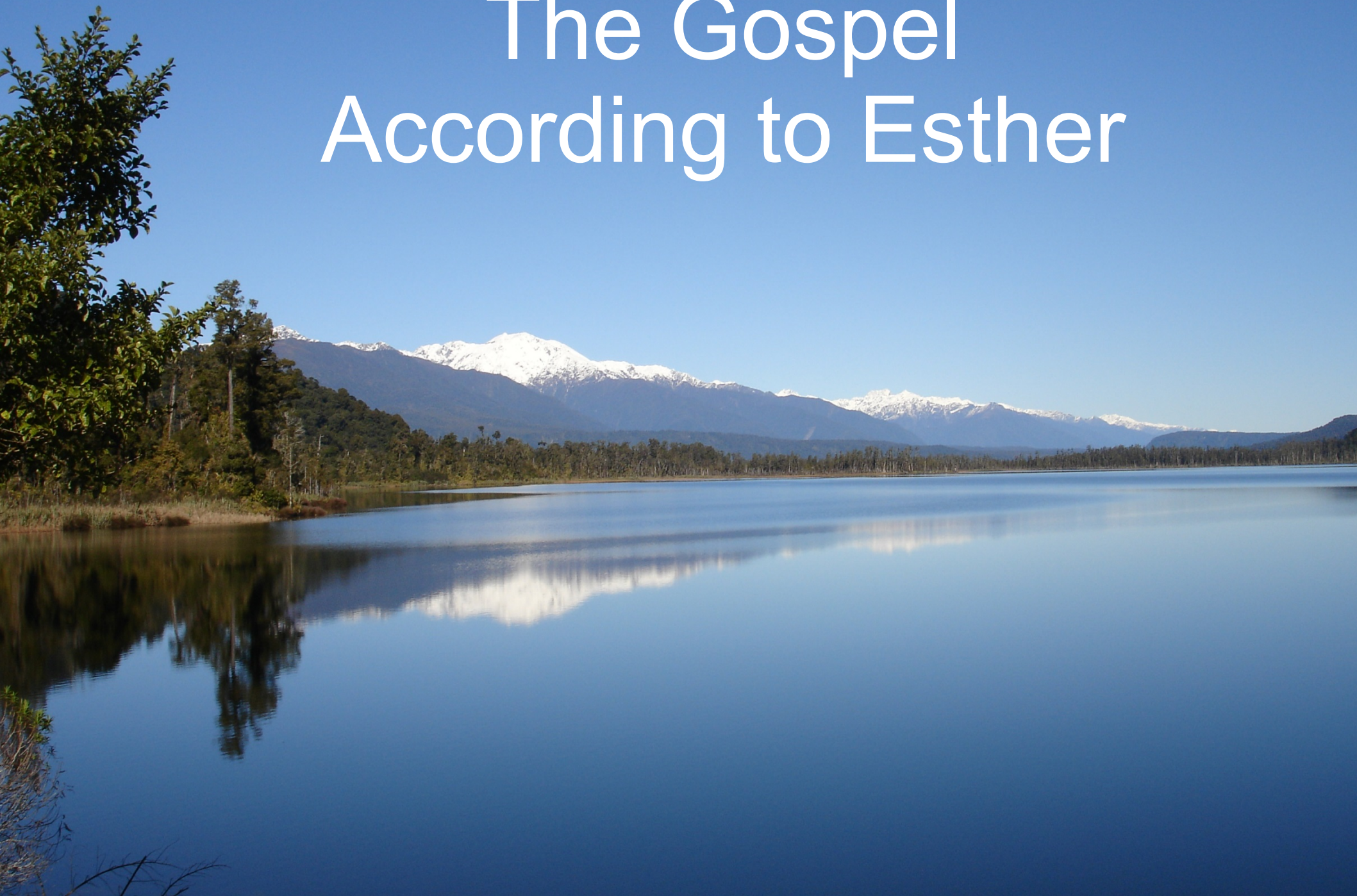
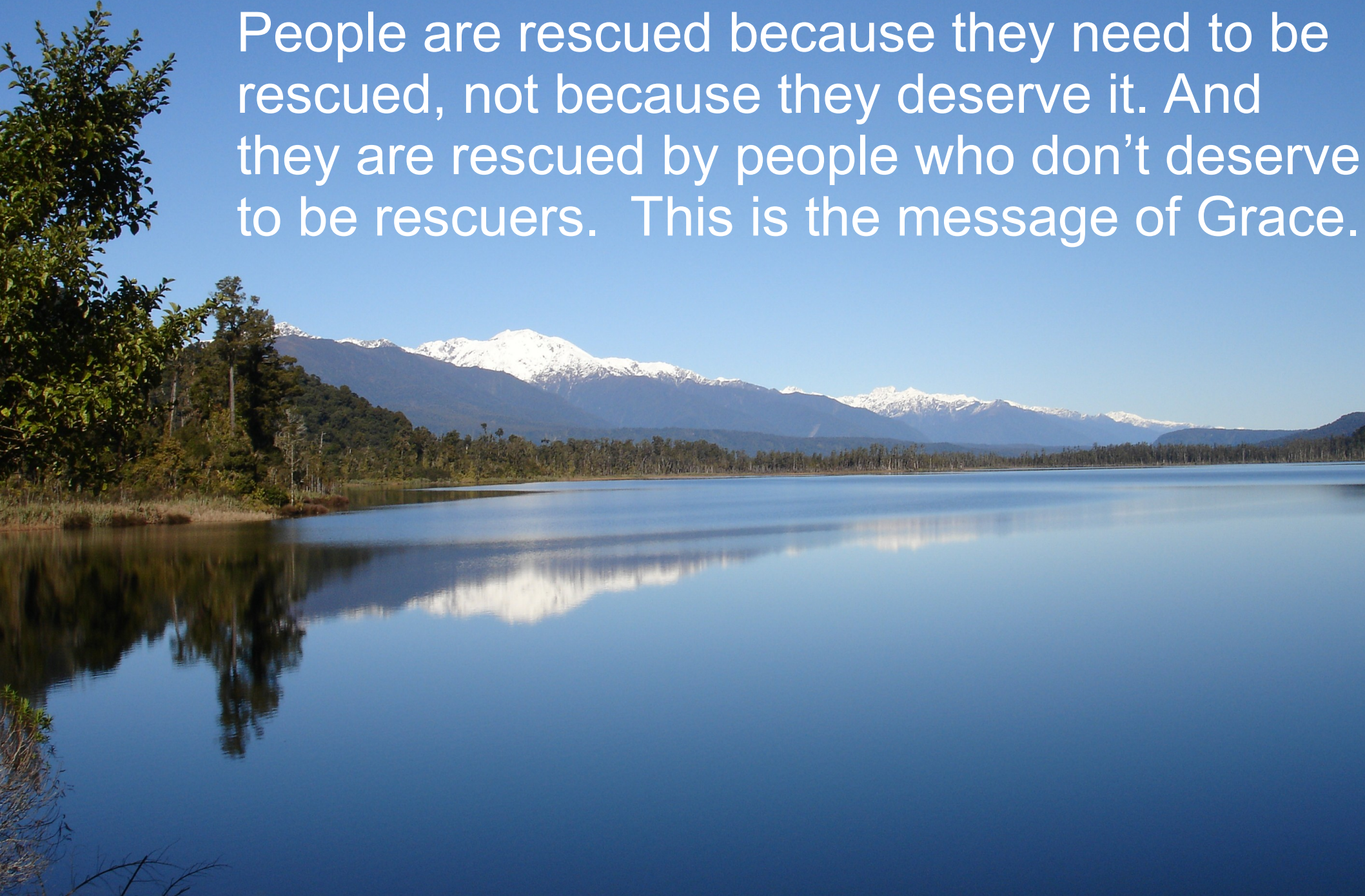
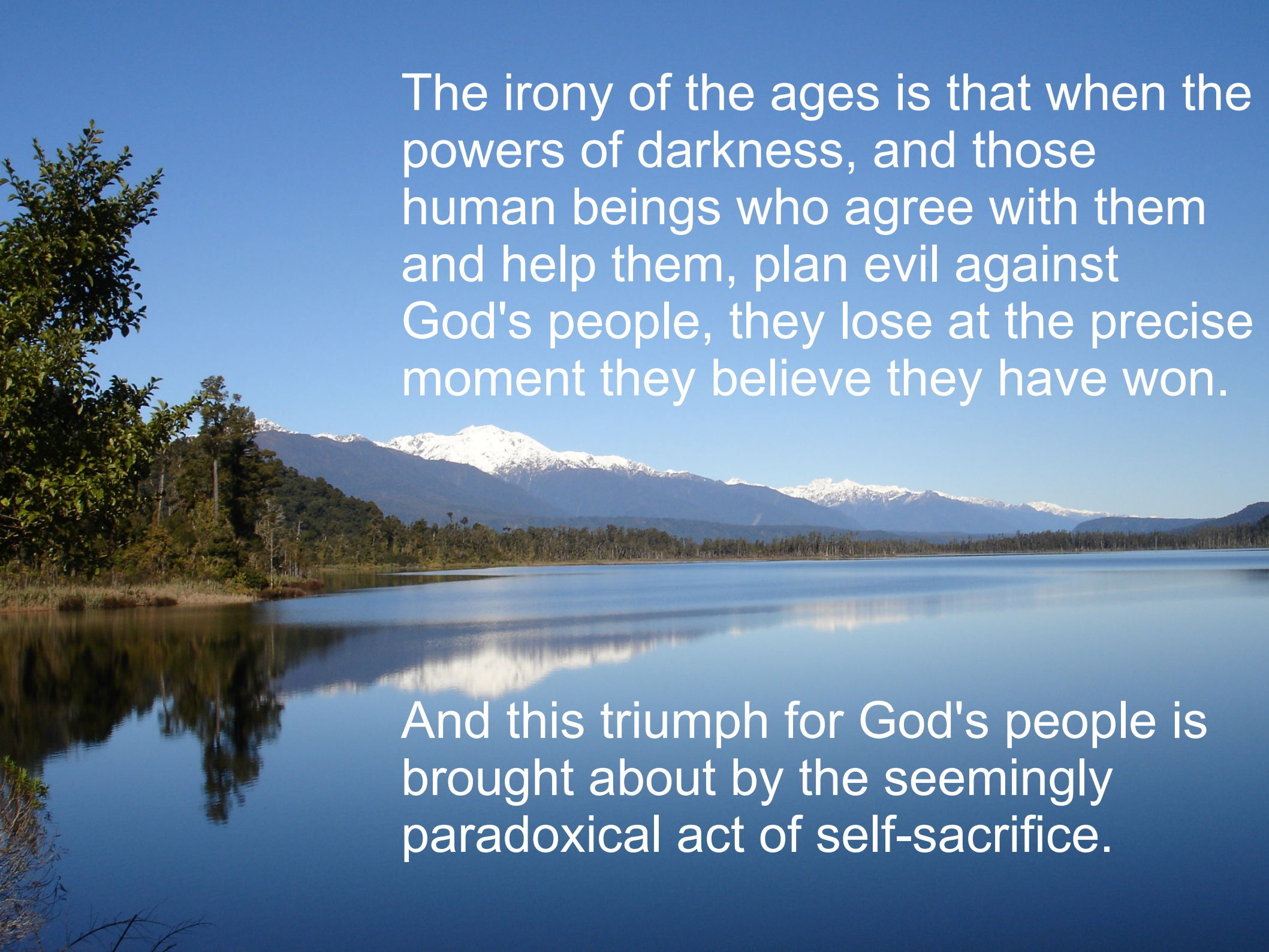


The Gospel According to Esther

And this triumph for God's people is brought about by the seemingly paradoxical act of self-sacrifice.

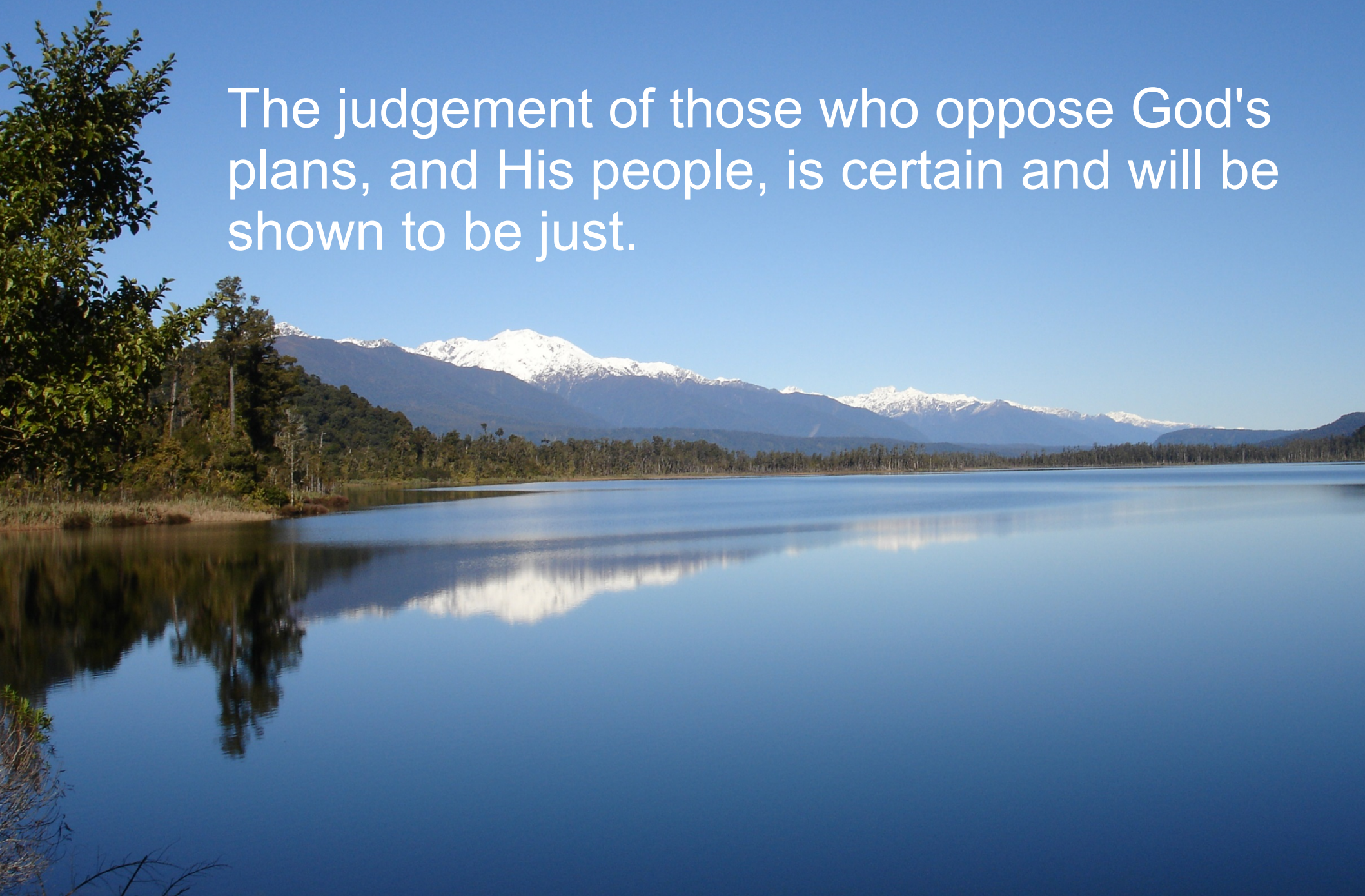
People who do whatever pleases them
